

Information for School Pupils Seeking Work Experience.

We receive a large number of requests for work experience placements. Restrictions within the Trident scheme now make it impracticable for us to accept students on Trident organised placements. However we are willing to take school pupils who wish to organise their own work experience. GCSE students are initially offered a single day's work experience at the equine practice. Other days can be organised within the small animal hospital or farm practice if requested.

Places at the equine practice are open to those GCSE students intending to go onto A levels and apply to veterinary schools. If your interest lies within other areas of the equine world, such as animal care courses, equine science or physiotherapy, we suggest you seek work experience in these areas rather than at an equine veterinary practice.

For A level students intending to apply to veterinary schools, work experience can be arranged in one week blocks. This should be spread over all species areas of the practice. We usually only have one school student on work experience within the practice at any one time, so it is best to get organised and try and book in well in advance. Please write with your request to the George Veterinary Hospital and we will try and help if we can. Please only apply if you have a genuine interest in pursuing a career in veterinary medicine.
