

## ESSENTIAL ITEMS FOR AN EFFECTIVE FIRST AID KIT FOR YOUR HORSE!



- COTTON WOOL—QUILTED ROLL
- SALINE 1 LITRE
- 50ML SYRINGE PLUS NEEDLE
- HIBISCRUB SURGICAL SCRUB \*
- SMALL CLEAN BUCKET
- DISPOSABLE GLOVES
- SCISSORS—FOR FIRST AID USE ONLY!
- MELOLIN DRESSING
- ALLEVYN 10X10cm DRESSING
- ALLEVYN 10X20cm DRESSING
- EASIFIX BANDAGE
- CO-PLUS BANDAGE
- ANIMALINTEX POULTICE
- NU-GEL
- DERMA-GEL

*\* Hibiscrub should always be used as a 1:50 dilution with water*

Further contents that would be useful in your first aid kit include:

- THERMOMETER
- VASELINE
- POLSTER-PLAST DRESSING
- SURGICAL SPIRIT
- DUCK TAPE

The “normal” ranges listed below may be useful to you, particularly if done on a regular basis by you—WHEN YOUR HORSE IS RELAXED AND WELL!

- TEMPERATURE - 37.5°-38.5° C
- PULSE (HEART RATE) - 30-40 BEATS PER MINUTE
- RESPIRATION (BREATHING RATE) - 8-12 BREATHS PER MINUTE
